Which steps should you take first?

1. Get an EORI-number (Economic Operator Registration and Identification number)

This is required for customs clearance. It's free to apply for your number and currently only takes a few days to be issued.

2. Contact DLG to deal with customs for you

DLG will gladly help you with all shipping documents and customs formalities that are needed for your shipments. Please send an email to brexit@dlg-logistics.com.

3. Create an account in our webportal

Via our webportal we can arrange all Brexit necessities for you.

How can DLG help?

- From 1 January 2021, we will require a commercial invoice and packing list with every shipment to take care of the export or import declaration with customs.
- Make sure that all information is mentioned on the documents and can be sent to DLG in time to avoid any delays at the border.
- You will need commodity codes for all your goods. This allows you to apply the correct rate of duty, keeps your business compliant with HMRC and allows us to correctly declare your shipments.
